

IWVGA pipeline funding discussion removed from County Supervisors' Tuesday agenda

An item scheduled for Tuesday's Kern County Board of Supervisors meeting to consider an agreement, which would authorize the Indian Wells Valley Groundwater Authority to act as the county's agent should the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers require the county's participation in building a pipeline to import water, was pulled from the agenda and will not be discussed.

The item was supposed to be considered at last Monday's special board meeting, but was continued to Tuesday because county counsel was unable to approve it in time while waiting for information from the Army Corps of Engineers.

Supervisor Phillip Peters said he pulled the item from the agenda. He also said there likely won't be any discussion on the Ridgecrest water situation at Tuesday's meeting.
